

**NOTES FROM THE ANNUAL PUBLIC MEETING  
OF THE SHERBURN IN ELMET PARISH COUNCIL  
HELD IN THE HARRY MOUNTAIN ROOM  
EVERSLEY PARK CENTRE  
ON MONDAY MAY 15<sup>TH</sup> 2017  
@ 6.45 pm**

**Present- Councillor P. Doherty (Chairman) and Mrs M. Gibson (Clerk)**

**Also present two members of the public. Parish Councillors in the audience also.**

Resident stated that at a public meeting held some time ago it was stated that Sherburn would get 700 houses and Tadcaster would also get housing. Resident asked **why Sherburn is getting 100's more houses and none are being built in Tadcaster**. Also when is the **Red Bear** going to be upgraded this is an eyesore in the village centre. Chairman states as Smiths own most of the land in Tadcaster they can stop any developments there.

The Project Manager for the Red Bear assured the council that work would commence in May. Councillor Lake will contact them again and find out when exactly this work will commence.

Resident asked when the **speed limit will be changed down Low Street with 700 houses** there and 4 accesses onto this road and it is still a 40mph limit there. Chairman states that the limit will be changed to 30 mph but there is a dispute with the builders regarding footpaths and cycle paths etc. There will also be a puffin crossing near to the new school entrance. Resident felt this should be 20mph but Chairman explained that this is unenforceable.

Resident also asked if anything being done to check **Air Quality and dust pollution levels**. Chairman stated this has not been done but he would certainly raise this question.

Resident also asked about white lines which need repainting as they are invisible at the moment. County Council are to do this later this year.

Resident also asked about **resident parking in Beechwood Glade** there is a sign stating Residents only parking but others do park there. Councillor Packham states that District Council erected these signs so this matter should be raised with them.
