

MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF SHERBURN-IN-ELMET PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE HARRY MOUNTAIN ROOM AT EVERSLEY PARK CENTRE ON MONDAY 29TH JULY 2013 AT 7PM

Kirkgate Old School:

The Chairman explained that the meeting had been called for the Parish Council to consider making a SIB application for a Pre-Feasibility Grant under the Community Right to Bid Scheme, to keep Kirkgate Old School.

It was agreed that the Chairman should go ahead and make the application.

The Chairman said that if this application was successful, in the absence of any other suggestions, he would propose the feasibility study be based on the use of the Old School as a Sports Centre. He suggested that it would be helpful if the "Friends of the Old Kirkgate School" get up a petition to the effect that the Old School should be kept as a village amenity and they would like to see it as a Sports Centre.

It was agreed that no action should be taken in respect of the petition until after the meeting with North Yorkshire County Council on Thursday 1st August 2013.
