

MINUTES OF THE LAND & PREMISES COMMITTEE MEETING OF SHERBURN-IN-ELMET PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON WEDNESDAY APRIL 3RD 2013 @7.30PM IN THE PARISH COUNCIL OFFICE.

18 Apologies for absence

There were no apologies..

19. Matters for discussion.

a) To Discuss “Snooker Walls” for Eversley Park area.

Clerk had not had catalogue through yet but had contacted them and these start at £8,997 installed. Chairman felt we would have to try and get grants for this we should look at Lottery funding, Councillor Haskell suggested the Proceeds of Crime funds. **Agreed we propose to full council that sites for this should be investigated and the Project Officer in the meantime look at what funding would be available.**

b) Scout St. Georges Day March.

Clerk reports that this has been cancelled, their head office refused permission for this event.

c) Check/ update Risk Assessment for our areas.

Chairman has been ill so not had chance to go through this with the Clerk. **This would be done in the next week and report at next Full council.**

d) To agree wording on plaque for Library Area.

Clerk reports cheque received today from Scireburnean Theatre Co. for £662.44 they are donating this to the council to provide a seat in the library area with an inscription which states this was “donated by the Scireburnean Theatre Company 2013” if any monies left over from this seat they wish that to be solely spent on seating for the village.

Chairman reports that Councillor Brown has sent a suggestion for the plaque for this area in memory of Barbara Wilson. **After much discussion it was proposed we ask Council to approve the following wording “ This garden has been created in memory of Barbara Wilson who worked hard for this village”.**

e) To discuss tree T12 on Low Street.

As reported at Council meeting tree number T11 has to be removed as unsafe, Mr Harrison has confirmed with James Carter that T12 has a cavity in it but should be ok for another year. Clerk asked if council want to leave it that year or have both done together. Mr Harrison is dealing with the TPO permission for both trees as we do not have to have them both done can leave other a year if we wish to do that, but cheaper to get both permissions at same time. **Agreed Clerk get prices for taking one down and also for the two doing together. This could be finally decided when these prices and the permission comes through.**

f) To Discuss Electrical Checks to PC owned Buildings.

Project Officer still chasing these up. Councillor Haskell reports that new Councillor Moerman had attended last nights EPC meeting and she had suggested asking 3 local firms for quotation for annual electrical checks on our 4 buildings plus giving us a fixed price per hour for any call outs for a 3 year period. Which would mean when/if anything goes wrong this company would be called on to do any work for the Council in that 3 year period. **Agreed**

Project Officer be asked to get this idea progressed and report to either next LAP or full council when quotes received.

g) To Discuss CCTV at Eversley Park.

Chairman reports that the monitor is not working, Project Officer had reported this to Oliver last week. **Clerk to chase this up with Oliver and also if the new CCTV round by Main Hall Fire door and grill and re-aligning number plate identity camera will be fixed at same time.**

EXTRA ITEMS.

Litter Pick.

Councillor Packham reports that the Scouts had helped with litter pick this time and lots of rubbish had been cleared. Chairman suggested that Community Association could maybe look at “badges” for young litter pickers to try and get more involved, **perhaps the young people could design a badge and we could than ask parish Council if they would fund these badges.** Councillor Prescott would take this suggestion to next Community Association meeting.

Angling Club

Councillor Haskell reports he had been down this weekend and Wincanton are working on the path around the pond. He did notice that one of the Lifebouys has been removed again. **Clerk to contact Mr Jordan and insist that this is replaced asap and must be left in situ at all times, as this is a Health & Safety hazard without one.**
