BUSINESS.

1. Matters for discussion

a) To check Health & Safety for all areas.

b) To discuss legionnaires check for Rugby Club

Project Officer got reply from Plumber he could do the check but does not issue certificate for this. **Agreed we get quote and for this and take to Finance meeting next week.**

c) To discuss where we want 170 trees (subsidised) planting. Much discussion took place and it was decided we did not have anywhere that this number of trees could be planted. Clerk to notify them of this decision.

d) To Discuss Conservation Charity e-mail passed from PC meeting. Agreed we did not have use for this at the present time.

e) Request to Metal Detect on PC Land -Following response from NY Archaeology Dept **Agreed we say no to this detecting.**
