

## SHERBURN-IN-ELMET PARISH COUNCIL

### MINUTES FROM THE LAND AND PREMISES COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 3<sup>rd</sup> MAY 2016 AT 7.PM IN THE PARISH COUNCIL OFFICE

1. **Apologies: Mrs B. Thwaite Mr M Hobson**
2. **Declarations of interest – None reported**
3. **Minutes from Previous Meeting - Accepted**
4. **Matters for discussion**
5. **Tree Survey dated April 2016**  
It was agreed accept the report and to action the areas marked as a Medium Risk – these were the Copse Group, TE13 (Apple), TE16 (Thorn) and TE17 Silver Birch all in Eversley Park. The items marked as Low or Very Low risk will be assessed at the next survey.

6. **Angling Club**  
Waiting for quotes to erect fencing separating public footpath and fishing pond. The problem of the dog walkers was discussed and it was suggested signage be posted informing owners to clean up after their dogs. Additionally, placing bins around the pond for the waste was suggested providing these can be positioned in areas where Selby District Council will empty them.

7. **Memorial Garden (Library)**  
There has been an upsurge in anti-social behaviour resulting in the gates along with the cage being illegally removed by vandals. These have been recovered and put in safe keeping at the Eversley Park Centre. It was agreed not to replace them. Rats have also been seen in this area so Selby District Council need to be contacted to confirm who is responsible for dealing with them.  
We need to liaise with the Police regarding enforcement action for this area. It was suggested that we speak to the Library regarding CCTV (or a dummy camera) to cover this area.

8. **Section 106 money – Fairways**  
It was explained that Councillor Packham had spoken with the Selby District Council Solicitor who was writing to tell the developers that some Section 106 money would be allocated for the 3G pitch at Sherburn High School. This will still leave a significant amount of Section 106 money which could be used at the Fairways, though some will not be available until Strata have sold 60 of their 120

homes. The Scouts have expressed an interest in the Fairways area and there is a need to coordinate all interested parties.

**9. Any Other Business**

Steve Foster has agreed for the Scouts to plant seeds in the Wildlife garden at Eversley Park.

Discussions regarding use of the tennis courts by the netball club have progressed well, but it was felt that before taking any further action the local Netball League should be asked to approve the proposals (there is no point having work done if it isn't acceptable to the Netball League).
