

Planning meeting 18th July 2012

There were no plans for consideration.

Chairman reported from Village Centre Working Group.

Optima have done a new traffic survey and this has been sent to our Consultants for evaluation. At the moment we have £750 budgeted for this work and we are at present to £650 costs, at full rate this would have been much more. It was agreed more funding would probably be needed and agreed we ask Council to consider this increase at the meeting tonight.

Chairman reports that this survey re-states what has already been said, but they are worried our figures may be correct. There is nothing on camera findings in this report. Agreed Clerks write to NYCC and also Persimmon asking for "formal disclosure of the traffic findings" and results of the camera reports. Councillor Packham stated it would be nice if they at least told us we were wrong if we are. Chairman reports that Tim Coyne is asking questions but whether he is looking at this impartially is another matter.

Chairman will contact Planning and find out when they will be deciding on this issue. He notices in this report it does state that £60,000 from S106 monies could be available to upgrade the traffic lights. They will then (we assume) be able to state that this system would cope with the extra traffic flows.
